A short letter of introduction with either a personal or family photograph, may be a way of starting to develop a relationship with your sponsored child. Correspondence with your child will benefit him or her from knowing that someone in addition to his or her family really cares. Your words of encouragement will make a big difference to your child.

When you set up your account we will give you an address that you can send mail to. Your child will write back to you, but please allow some time to elapse before receiving the response of your child, this may depend on several factors like communication network, long distances, remote locations and inadequate postal services, depending on where the child lives.
